

**<u>Purpose</u>**: To outline the procedure utilized to establish a Tanker Task Force (TTF) response for fire related incidents, subsequent to the dispatch of a Box Alarm.

**General:** A Tanker Task Force shall consist of the following:

- Three (3) tankers
- One (1) Engine Company

## Note:

- Any officer or unit responding to or on the scene of an incident may request from the ECC a Tanker Task Force.
- The Tanker Task Force is not part of the second alarm. If a second alarm is subsequently requested, a full alarm assignment in addition to the Tanker Task Force will be dispatched.
- The Engine Company shall notify Command that they are responding and request an assignment. Strong consideration should be given that the TTF Engine Company report to the nearest water supply for a fire in a non-hydrant area (manpower can be brought to the scene prior to going to the water supply).
- The Incident Commander should consider the need to keep the TTF Engine Company in staging.
