<u>Purpose</u>: To establish a system of consistent standards pertaining to operational helmets, and helmet fronts (shields) for all Jefferson County Fire and EMS Departments.

General:

• Helmets shall be from an NFPA approved manufacturer, within reasonable condition.

• Helmets shall be a certain color directly related to the rank of the individual to which the helmet is assigned:

Fire Line Officer

EMS Line Officer

Staff Officer (Including Safety Officers)

All Cleared Interior Firefighters

Exterior Only

Exterior EMS Only Staff

Junior Member

White

White

White

Yellow/Black/White, at Chiefs Discretion

Yellow/Black

Red

Red

Red with Star of Life Sticker on Sides

Green

• Shields, or helmet fronts, shall be a certain color directly related to the rank of the individual to which the helmet shield is assigned:

Chief Officers (Fire and EMS)	Gold or White
Fire and EMS Line Officers	White
Staff Officers (Including Safety Officer)	Black
All Cleared Interior Firefighters	Black
Exterior Only	Red
Junior Member	Orange

- All helmet shields shall have the Individual Rank (Firefighter, Fire Chief, etc.) and Last Name. Individuals may choose to have a first initial added as well (J. Doe).
- All helmet shields shall have a Velcro center area for use with a shield insert compatible with the Accountability requirements established in OG #16-14.

• All apparatus shall have shield inserts specific to that apparatus. Shield inserts shall confirm to the following standards: (Note: Unit Offer insert will be White, with lettering colored as described below)

Engine	E#	RED
Truck	T#	GREEN
Duty/Utility	D# or U#	GOLD
Ambulance or EMS Veh.	A# or EMS#	BLUE
Brush	В#	ORANGE
Tanker or Engine Tanker	K# or ET#	YELLOW
Rescue or Rescue Engine	R# OF RE#	BLACK
