A. Awarded

- a. Eastern Area Health and Education Grant-James Hite Park trail. \$40,000. We have been reimbursed \$20,000. The remainder of the grant will be paid out in May.
- b. LWCF in the amount of \$99,000 was awarded for soccer fields at James Hite Park. Requested an extension until December 2016 that was approved by the National Park Service. The \$10,000 balance left on the grant will be held until I file for completion. Leaving the grant open allows for potential funding.
