The County Commission of Jefferson County, West Virginia will be accepting sealed bids for painting the Historic Jefferson County Courthouse. The scope of this work will include painting the Courthouse and repairing damaged bricks/masonry.

We are requesting the submission of two bids for this project. One bid will be based on the Historic Structures Report and the other bid will be based on the Cross-Section Paint Microscopy Report. A mandatory pre-bid meeting and walkthrough will be held on Friday, September 7, 2018, at 10:00 a.m. Please meet at the front entrance of the Courthouse at 100 East Washington Street, Charles Town, WV 25414 for this meeting/walkthrough.

Sealed bids must be received by Wednesday, September 19, at 10:00 a.m. Bids can be mailed or hand-delivered to the Jefferson County Maintenance Department, 128 Industrial Blvd, Kearneysville, WV 25430. Please mark clearly on the outside of your bid, "Sealed Courthouse Paint Bid."

All bidders must provide references. The successful bidder must provide proof of insurance, bonding and be in good standing with the State of West Virginia.
