ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a Jefferson County public, private or home school student in 6th-8th grades starting in the Fall.
- Submit a complete YAC application form, supplemental questionnaire, and at least one letter of recommendation from a teacher, coach or advisor.
- All applicants will be interviewed, and if accepted, will sign a year-long agreement committing to a full 1-year term in accordance with the JCPS school year.

REQUIREMENTS

All YAC members must be able to commit to a minimum of the following:

- Attend at least 6 YAC meetings (September-May) on the 1st Friday of the month from 5:00-6:30pm at the Jefferson County Community Center. Additional meetings may be required depending on event schedules.
- Attend 1 Jefferson County Parks & Recreation Commission meeting (September-May) which are held the 3rd Wednesday of each month at 7:00pm.
- Help plan, attend and volunteer at least 1-2 YAC Fundraisers, 1-2 Community Service Projects and 1-2 JCPRC events.
- YAC must be represented by at least 2 members at all JCCC Teen Nights (September-May)
