



SAM MICHAEL'S DOG PARK

Rules & Regulations

Please be aware owners and their dogs use this space at their OWN RISK.

By using this space, you understand and accept the risk that your participation includes physical injury, and you agree to hold harmless the county from any and all suits.

-  Dogs with a known history of dangerous or aggressive behavior are **PROHIBITED**.
-  In-acordance with the Jefferson County Leash Laws, your dog(s) must be leashed prior to entering and exiting the park. The **ONLY** place dogs are permitted off-leash is in the fenced-in dog park.
-  Dogs must be immediately removed from the area at the first sign of aggression toward people, animals, or other dogs.
-  Dogs must be under voice control at all times. Owners must stay with their dogs **INSIDE** the fenced dog park at all times. This is **NOT A DROP OFF** dog park.
-  Owners must dispose of their dog's waste in trash receptacles immediately.
-  Dogs must be licensed, current on vaccinations, and wearing ID at all times.
-  Sick dogs are prohibited
-  All dogs six months and older must be spayed or neutered.
-  Children must be closely supervised. This means within grabbing distance if needed.
-  Limit 2 dogs per person.
-  No food (dog or human) inside the area. This includes chew-type toys, rawhide, etc.
-  No water or food bowls may be brought into the area.
-  No animals other than dogs are permitted in this area.
-  Smoking is prohibited.
-  Please note: There are wooded areas located within the fenced area.

HANDLERS ARE LEGALLY RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY INJURY CAUSED BY THEIR DOGS.
