DEMOLITION of Residential/Commercial/Industrial

Instructions for Building Permit Application & Inspections

Jefferson County building permit requirements are only applicable for property located within the unincorporated areas of Jefferson County and do not apply in the five incorporated jurisdictions: Charles Town, Ranson, Harpers Ferry, Bolivar and Shepherdstown.

TO OBTAIN A PERMIT:

- 1. Application filled out completely.
- 2. Water Service Termination provide one of the following:
 - a. A letter from County Health Department stating existing well is properly abandoned; or
 - b. A letter from Public Service District stating service is properly terminated.
- 3. Sewer Service Termination provide one of the following:
 - a. A letter from County Health Department stating existing Septic system is abandoned; orb. A letter from Public Service District stating service is properly terminated.
- 4. Electric Service Termination provide a letter from the electric utility company stating that the electric service is properly terminated.
- 5. Gas Service (if applicable): provide a letter from gas utility stating gas service is properly terminated.
- 6. Demolition Plan/Sketch showing:
 - Property/Parcel shape with approximate location of all structures and the types (see page 4)
 - \circ $\;$ Type and location of temporary safety barriers.
- 7. Permit fee paid: \$125 for Residential or Commercial / Industrial.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- <u>Note:</u> Your Permit will only be issued once it has been reviewed and approved. Typically allow 7 to 10 business days for review (depending on work load), which begins only after all the information is 100% complete and received by the Office of Permits & Inspections.
- Check with WVDEP for required asbestos inspection & asbestos removal requirements.

INSPECTIONS REQUIRED:

- 1. Pre-Demolition (after protective barriers are in place & prior to beginning demolition work).
- 2. Prior to backfill of basement foundation (if applicable).
- 3. Final (upon completion of all work).

SCHEDULING AN INSPECTION:

Schedule an inspection by calling 304-725-2998; from 9:00 am-5:00 pm, Monday-Friday.

Have the following information available prior to calling to schedule an inspection:

- 1. Permit Number. (INSPECTION WILL NOT BE SCHEDULED WITHOUT PERMIT #, No Exceptions)
- 2. Owner Name and/or Subdivision & Lot Number.
- 3. Type of Inspection requested (see "Inspections Required" above).
- 4. Name & phone number of person scheduling the inspection.

Inspections scheduled by 3:00 pm will usually be performed within 48 hours of that business day. No appointments or times are set for inspections.

DEMOLITION PLAN/SKETCH SHEET

- Sketch the shape of the lot & provide the size of the lot.
- Show location of adjacent roads and the road names; and streams and stream names.
- Show all existing rights-of-way and/or easements on the property.
- Location of structure(s) to be <u>demolished</u> and label the type of structure (dwelling, garage, shed, etc.)
- Location of structures to <u>remain</u> and label the type of structures.
- Show height (1, 2 or 3 story, etc.) and size (dimensions) of structure to be demolished.
- Show & label type (i.e., chain link fence, snow fence or other type) and location of protective barriers.

OWNER/APPLICANT'S CERTIFICATION OF INTENT AND ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY

I, (We) the Owner(s) of the property on which the intended demolition is located, hereby certify and ensure that the demolition complies with all restrictive covenants of this property/real estate, and I, (We) agree, understand and acknowledge that I, (We) assume full responsibility for compliance with any such private land use, covenants and restrictions, and that a violation thereof may result in legal sanctions by court injunction, fines and civil damages, irrespective of the issuance of this permit by Jefferson County.

I, (We) further acknowledge and understand that:

- Any demolition prior to the issuance of this permit is in violation of the Jefferson County Ordinances and is subject to prosecution to the fullest extent of the law. This includes site work, barricade construction, building construction, etc.
- Demolition shall not begin until the demolition plan is approved.
- By signing this application, it is understood that employees, representatives and or agents of the
 Jefferson County Engineering Department, Permits & Inspections, are authorized to enter in and/or
 upon the property for the purposes of performing site plan and building code compliance inspections
 and to check for code violations related to the property, site work and/or building activities identified on
 this application.
- The property owner(s) is/are responsible for providing employees, representatives, and/or agents of the Jefferson County Engineering Department, safe and open access to the site and all building components when conducting inspections.
- All Roadways and properties shall be protected from damage and the deposit of mud, dirt, silt, trash and debris, etc., resulting from work covered by this permit application.
- The Property owner(s) shall be responsible for any resulting damage and clean-up costs.

BEFORE YOU DO ANY RENOVATION OR DEMOLITION YOU MUST HAVE YOUR BUILDING OR HOME INSPECTED FOR THE PRESENCE OF "ASBESTOS"

WHAT DOES THE LAW STATE ABOUT RENOVATION AND DEMOLITION ACTIVITIES?

ASBESTOS ABATEMENT LICENSING RULE WEST VIRGINIA LEGISLATIVE RULES DIVISION OF HEALTH TITLE 64 SERIES 63 1998

This rule established procedures and standards for the training and licensure of persons engaging in activities relating to asbestos abatement activities. This rule also identified the responsibilities of owners of building or other man-made structures where asbestos activities are being conduced.

Responsibilities of Owners

The owner must ensure that each building or other man-made structure he or she owns is inspected for the presence of asbestos by a licensed asbestos inspector prior to any renovation or demolition activities;

64-63-2. Definitions

2.14. Building or Other Man-Made Structure. A building or a part of a building, or a group of buildings on the same premises, or any other type of manmade construction, such as a pipeline, barn, shed, trailer, or any appurtenance to a building or other man-made structure. 2.3. Asbestos Abatement: Procedures to control fiber release from asbestoscontaining materials.

2.4. Asbestos Abatement Project: An activity involving the repair, removal, enclosure, or encapsulation of asbestoscontaining material: Provided, That the removal of less than three (3) square feet or three (3) linear feet of asbestos containing materials required in the performance of a maintenance activity not intended solely as asbestos abatement is not considered to be an asbestos abatement project.

ASBESTOS FACT SHEET where can asbestos be found?

• Exterior Surfaces: window putty, roof felt, shingles, mastics and cement asbestos board siding.

• Interior Surfaces: sprayed on popcorn acoustical ceilings, wall and ceiling plasters, heat reflectors (woodstoves) and acoustical tiles.

• Heating and Ventilation: heat source covering, door and cover gaskets, pipe insulation, and air duct covering.

• Flooring: sheet vinyl's, tiles and mastics.

This does not include every product or material that may contain asbestos, but is intended as a general guide to show various types of materials that may contain asbestos.

HERE ARE THE STEPS YOU NEED TO TAKE AS THE OWNER



Retain a West Virginia licensed asbestos inspector to conduct an inspection of areas affected by the renovation and/or demolition activity.



If no asbestos-containing materials (ACM) are identified, you may proceed with renovation or demolition activities. Provided that you have also complied with the applicable requirements of WV Code of State Rule 45 CSR 15 - EMISSION STANDARDS FOR HAZARDOUS AIR POLLUTANTS PURSUANT TO 40 CFR PART 61, administered by the WV Department of Environmental Protection – Division of Air Quality. 

COMMON MATERIALS CONTAINING ASBESTOS

Asbestos has properties which made it suitable for use as insulation and as part of binding materials in buildings. Asbestos has been used in such parts of the home as floor tiles, ceiling panels, acoustical ceilings, exterior stuccos, etc. All in all there have been over 3600 products manufactured that contain asbestos. It would be impossible to list all of these products here. The only sure way to find out if the material you are concerned with contains asbestos is to have the material tested. Refer to the following diagram for the most common products that may contain asbestos.
