Guidelines to Reopen Parks and Recreation after Temporary Closure Due to COVID19

The JCPRC actions will be guided by the orders of the Governor of the State of West Virginia, the orders of the Jefferson County Health Department, and the guidelines published by the Centers for Disease Control.

Preparation

Parks & Trails

- Essential services: garbage pickup, mowing, preparation of parks for reopening
- No park or park amenity will be opened until parks have been prepared for reopening with appropriate measurements for social distancing, sanitation, and PPE.
- Park trails remain open for usage
- Closed parks and amenities:

Facilities

- Essential services: preparation of facilities for reopening and providing necessary protocols and PPE for staff
- No facility will be opened until it has been prepared for reopening with appropriate measurements for social distancing and sanitation

Front Desk

- Maintain 6-foot human spacing in front of counter (signage will be placed throughout the lobby and floors)

- Staff using sanitizer and hand washing as often as possible and in between each customer
- Setting any items for the customer/patron directly onto the counter to avoid human contact

Recreation/Programming

- Online, virtual programming continues.
- Modified programming that maximizes physical distancing and limits group size
- Programs are held outside when possible
- Doors remain open to help with ventilation when possible.
- Instructors and participants will be asked to wash hands before and after classes
- Hand sanitizer will be placed at the entrance of each classroom
- Participants encouraged to use restroom prior to arriving for class
- An entrance/exit strategy will be in place for each room to reduce the potential for contact in hallways and classrooms
- Classes utilizing the same room will be 30 minutes apart to allow safe transitions and time to sanitize
- Participants asked to arrive no more than 5 minutes prior to class
- Participants should arrive dressed and ready for class
 - Participants will be encouraged to bring their own equipment
- Activity rooms/Gym will be limited to participants only and parents will be asked to wait outside until five minutes prior to class ending
