Hello everyone!

As we continue to muddle our way through the COVID-19 pandemic, we continue to develop new ways to join our community together for recreational fun.

This fall, you will notice a combination of vitual and in-person classes. Some things you should notice:

- In-person classes are accepting registrations at a 40% capacity.
- Any person who wishes to enter the Jefferson County Community Center will require a health screening, including a no-touch temperature screening.
- Facemasks are required for entry into the Community Center.
- Non-participants are discouraged from waiting for the participant inside the Community Center lobby, although we know in some cases it will be necessary.
- Programs and activities are created in conjunction with guidelines provided by the Jefferson County Health Department and WV DHHR. If COVID-19 concerns arise and classes must be canceled, pro-rated class fees will be refunded.

- Hand sanitizer is provided in numerous locations around the Community Center. Please wash hands and sanitize to the greatest extent.
- During this time, buildings are cleaned and sanitized more frequently; however if you have concerns about any touchpoints, please notify our staff.

Application Procedure

To be considered for a Jefferson County Parks & Recreation Commission Scholarship, a signed application with the following documentation must be submitted.

- Proof of Residency (valid driver's license, utility bill, tax statement/bill or other proof of residency AND
- Verification from the Department of Social Services <u>OR</u>
- Letter demonstrating need.

Application Review & Reward

Upon receipt of a scholarship application, Jefferson County Parks & Recreation Commission staff will review the application (10-15 business days) and will make a financial assistance determination based upon the information submitted. The application will not be processed until all necessary documents are provided. All applicants will be notified once a decision has been made and the applicant's account will be activated immediately.

Reverification

Once the scholarship has been awarded, the applicant is required to re-verify their income and household size every twelve (12) months and/or when re-applying in order to maintain their scholarship discount.

Payments & Refunds

Payment is due when registering for any Jefferson County Parks & Recreation program, without exception, JCPRC accepts cash and credit cards. Refunds for cancellations are issued as a credit on your JCPRC account. No cash refunds will be given. If the applicant does not attend the program without prior notice to JCPRC the entire scholarship will be forfeited.

Jefferson County Parks and Recreation Cancellation/Refund Policy

Our refund policy encourages early decisions, so as to not affect other customers or our ability to deliver efficient programs. All requests for refunds must be made prior to the start of the program. Registrations that require advanced tickets are not refundable. Refunds for Sports League registrations must be made prior to the listed league registration deadline. There are no refunds for missed sessions.

After initial registration, refund requests must be submitted in writing via refund request form and will be honored in the following manner:

Additional fees, including out-of-county fees, supply or material fees, t-shirt costs, or others, will not be included in the refund or credit.

Any time a transfer from one program to another program is requested by a customer, there will be a \$5 transfer fee added to the transaction.

If a program or activity is canceled due to low enrollment, a full refund or credit will be issued to your account within seven business days of the cancellation. No administrative fees will apply.

If a program or activity is canceled due to inclement weather, and is not able to be rescheduled, a credit will be issued to your JCPRC account within 7 days of the missed class.

If JCPRC reschedules or offers a make-up for missed or canceled classes, no refunds or credits will be issued.
