Notes:

If Route J is chosen in its entirety, ~357 addressable structures lay within the 2200' corridor. (within 1100' of proposed power line route).

If Route K is chosen over the existing northern route through West Ridge Hills, ~254 addressable structures lay within the 2200' corridor. (within 1100' of proposed power line route).

Addressable Structures are used as a proxy for properties. Vacant parcels are also impacted by the PATH route but were not available for proximity analysis.

Numbers of other features are noted in legend.
