The Jefferson County Parks & Recreation Commission will be offering a Counselor-In-Training (CIT) program for teens, ages 13-17, who are seeking leadership and work experience through a summer camp work setting. Qualified and selected teens will go through an interview process as if they were applying for a camp counselor position. Selected candidates will be selected for 1-3 weeks of camp to work in a camp setting of their choosing (day camps, sports camps, art camps, special interest camps, etc.). This summer, JCPRC will be selecting up to 10 qualified candidates into this program. At the end of each week of camp your child works, they will be evaluated on how they did. The goal of this program is to prepare children for potential work experiences and the possibility of becoming a paid junior counselor. This is also an excellent way to get volunteer hours. Applications are being accepted until Friday, March 23rd. Candidates may choose up to 3 weeks of camps.

There will be a registration cost of \$75 associated with this program.





Scholarship Program



Dear Residents,

Jefferson County Parks and Recreation is proud to have a Scholarship program in place to make recreation available to more of our residents in Jefferson County.

JCPRC recognizes that there are residents of Jefferson County who require financial assistance in order to participate in certain activities through parks and recreation. It is important to continue to ensure that the most vulnerable and stressed individuals do not lose access to the important social and physical benefits realized through leisure activities.

This assistance are available while still being mindful of revenues needed to provide high quality programs at an affordable cost to all. Scholarships are awarded to Jefferson County residents only. Scholarships are subsidized by various avenues, including program fees and an allocation from the Jefferson County Commission.

Donations subsidize a small percentage of the scholarships awarded annually. Donations to the scholarship fund are received by way of the parks and recreation registration form where other registrants pledge a contribution amount.

Scholarships are granted based on financial need. Applicants complete the standard activity registration form and a 1 page form providing household information including: family size, employment information of all adults in the household, status of federal free or reduced lunch program, total household income, the amount they are able to pay towards the program, and explanation of extenuating circumstances.

An individual scholarship is limited to 50% of the class fee.

MORGAN GROVE PARK

With over twenty acres of shade trees, meadows, playgrounds, and spring-fed streams, this popular park serves as an idyllic site for community gatherings and events. A 1500 square foot covered picnic pavilion with a full kitchen and restroom facility offers the perfect place to host family events as well as corporate functions. Other features of the park include playground equipment, soccer fields, sand volleyball, horseshoe pits, and a 3/4 mile walking trail.

SAM MICHAELS PARK



The entrance to this one hundred and thirty acre park is located on Job Corps Road, near Harpers Ferry. The private setting of this park offers the perfect place to host weddings, receptions, and reunions and family events. The well shaded Mason Picnic Pavilion offers an adjacent kitchen and restroom facility. The Veterans Memorial Pavilion offers picnic tables, bathrooms and close proximity to the large playground area and Jefferson County Community Center. You will also find The Columns at Sam Michaels, baseball fields, athletic fields, playgrounds, walking and running trails, dog park, disc golf, event space and more. The Sam Michael's Amphitheater is under construction.

JAMES HITE PARK



Our newest 119-acre park that includes a 2-mile walking trail, soccer and football fields and picnic pavilions. Future plans include, playground, dog park and softball fields.

BOLIVAR NATURE PARK



Located on primrose alley, near Harpers Ferry, this 7-acre park is filled with plenty of botanical delights. A walking trail allows you to stroll through the park.

MOUNT MISSION PARK



This picturesque three and one-half acre park is located on Mission Road, near Shannondale. The picnic pavilion, complete with restroom and kitchen facilities, has played host to family reunions, weddings, and birthday parties. An old church on site, a newly renovated playground, new basketball hoop, horseshoe pits, sand volleyball and a baseball diamond make this park a convenient site for neighborhood get-togethers.



Located one mile East of Leetown, on off of old Leetown Pike, this ten-acre park has been a gathering for softball games since the 1970's. On the park grounds are lighted softball fields, tennis courts, a playground, picnic pavilion, horse shoe pits, concession stand and new renovated restroom facility. This park offers a great place to host your company's softball league or to simply relax and just play a pick-up game of baseball.

SOUTH JEFFERSON PARK

MOULTON PARK




