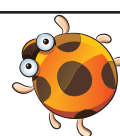
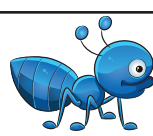

Scholarship Program



Eligibility

The scholarship program is available to **Jefferson County Residents Only**. Eligibility for a scholarship is based upon gross annual income and household size (see eligibility table below). Proper documentation must be submitted in order to be considered for eligibility (see income documentation). If the applicant does not have the required documentation then they must have income verified by Jefferson County West Virginia, Department of Social Services using their standard income verification process and methods.

Benefits

Recreational Programs and Camps: The Jefferson County Parks & Recreation Commission scholarship provides a discounted fee for classes, programs and camps on a sliding scale based on gross annual income and household size (see eligibility table below).

Annual Benefits Cap: Eligible households are allowed maximum retail value of \$200.00 in recreation classes during the fiscal year (7/1-6/30). After the maximum has been met, the discount will be void until the following fiscal year and subject to re-verification.

Application Procedure & Income Documentation

In order to be considered for a Jefferson County Parks & Recreation Commission Scholarship a signed application with the following documentation must be submitted.

- Proof of Residency (valid driver's license, utility bill, tax statement/bill or other proof of residency and
- A signed copy of all adult applicants current U.S. Individual Federal Income Tax Return (see below) or
- Financial information from the Department of Social Services.

Tax Return Information

For applicants submitting their current U.S. Individual Tax Return (Form 1040A or 1040EZ), you must submit Tax returns for all working adults listed on the application. The total number of people listed on the application will be used to determine the household size on the discount (above) and the income documentation must match.

Special Instructions

- If the filing status on the tax return is checked "Married filing Separately" the applicant must submit their spouses tax return.
- If the applicant can be claimed as a dependent on their tax return, the applicant must provide the tax return of the person claiming them as a dependent.

Application Review & Reward

Upon receipt of a scholarship application, Jefferson County Parks & Recreation Commission staff will review the application (10-15 business days) and will make a financial assistance determination based upon the information submitted. The application will not be processed until all necessary documents are provided. All applicants will be notified once a decision has been made and the applicant's account will be activated immediately.

Reverification

Once the scholarship has been awarded, the applicant is required to re-verify their income and household size every twelve (12) months and/or when re-applying in order to maintain their scholarship discount.

Payments & Refunds

Payment is due when registering for any Jefferson County Parks & Recreation program, without exception, JCPRC accepts Cash and Credit Cards. Refunds for cancellations are issued as a credit on your JCPRC account no cash refunds will be given. If the applicant does not attend the program without prior notice to JCPRC the entire scholarship will be forfeited.

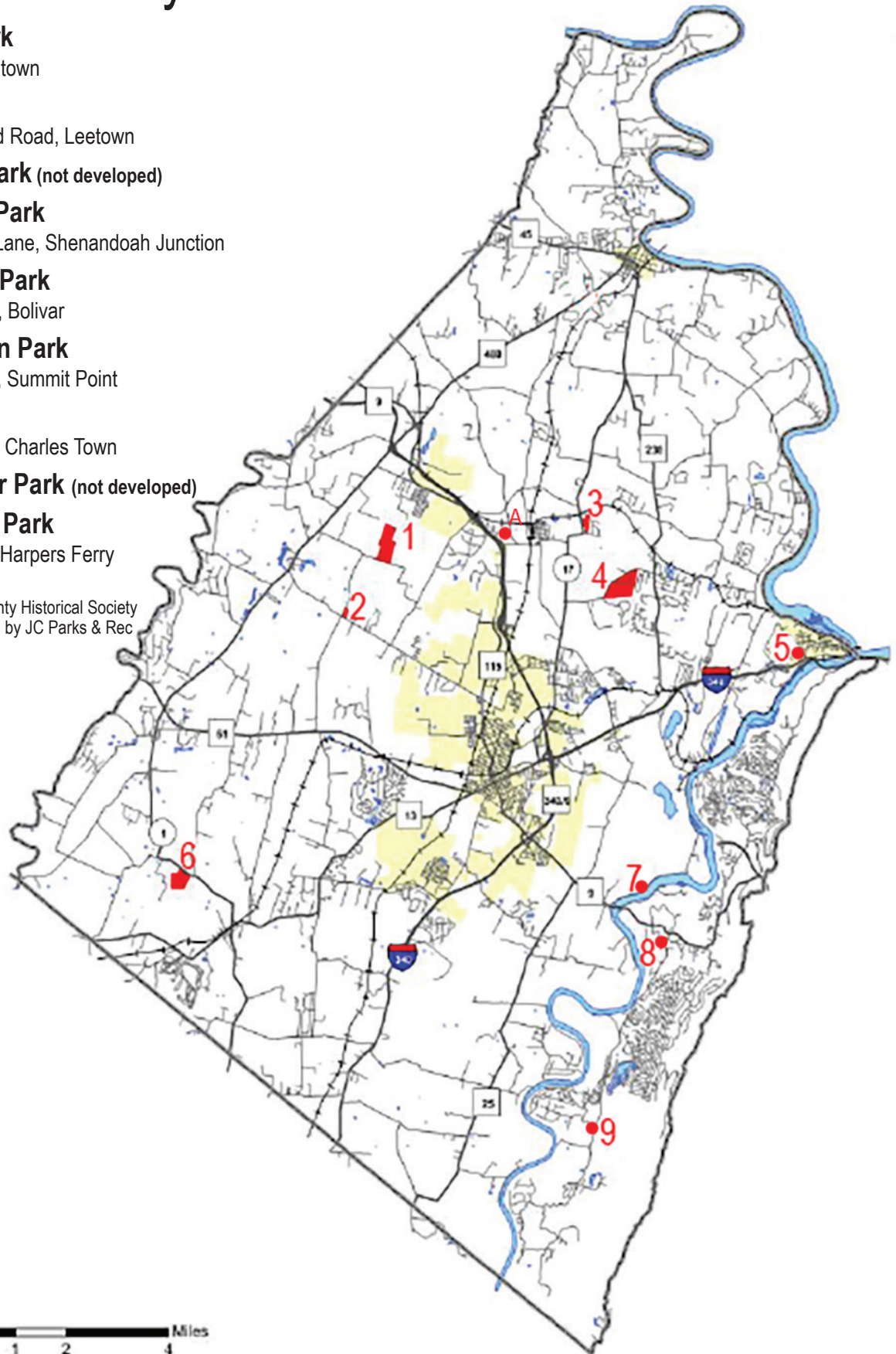
