
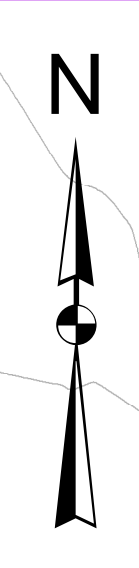


# 2023 EMS and Fire Territories in Jefferson County, WV



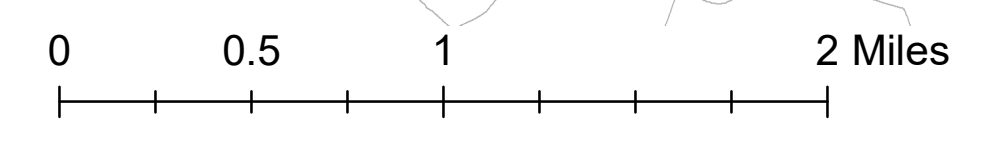

Boundaries are generated by each Fire Company in order to clarify order of dispatch, what equipment is needed, and if there are any special requirements for an area. The first due company for each box is designated with the first number of the box (ex: 100 boxes are Company 1 boxes).
