Minutes

Jefferson County Homeland Security and Emergency Management's Public Awareness Committee met at the Jefferson County EOC on September 7, 2010 at 9am. Present were: Terri Mehling, JCHSEM; Jennifer D. Maggio, JCHSEM and Debbi Palmer, Eastern Panhandle ARC.

Ms. Mehling opened the meeting.

Old Business

Ms. Mehling reported there are a total of 278 children that will be involved in the Disaster Ready Kids 2010 Program. Ms. Mehling will be working on getting additional volunteers to read to the children.

Ms. Mehling reviewed last week's Jefferson County Fair August 22-2. Surveys that were filled out by fair attendees will be compiled in a spreadsheet and hopefully reported in the next newsletter.

Ms. Mehling reviewed upcoming events during National Preparedness Month. Family Disaster Preparedness Night was September 1st with a total attendance of 4 people as well as Jeremy Scott from WEPM radio. Ms. Mehling noted this week's Lunch-N-Learn session will be about financial preparedness for before and after emergencies. Ms. Mehling asked Ms. Maggio to send a short press release to the media regarding the upcoming Lunch-N-Learn on Thursday. Business Continuity Planning will be September 27th at the Holiday Inn Express. Sessions will be held at 1:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. Ms. Mehling reviewed additional activities which include; 9-11 Remembrance at Independent Fire Company; Wal-Mart discounts on disaster supply kit items and the Drill Down for Safety. Ms. Mehling asked Ms. Palmer to display photo contest rules in the lobby of the Public Services Building. Ms. Palmer accepted.

Ms. Palmer reviewed upcoming activities for the American Red Cross. Activities included: September 11th, Health Fair & Preparedness Event, Covenant Baptist Church; September 15th, DAT Meeting, Berkeley County; October 2nd, Client Casework Class, Pendleton County and October 16th and Fulfilling our Mission, Shelter Ops, Mass Care, Pendleton County.

Ms. Mehling noted the Committee's meeting time will be changed to Wednesdays at 8:30 a.m. The next scheduled meeting will be October 13 at 8:30 a.m.

Ms. Mehling announced a new CERT class will begin October 12th. A press release will be out shortly.

Ms. Mehling reported she will be attending CERT Train-the-Trainer and Program Manager Course at Emergency Management Institute October 18-22.

Ms. Mehling reminded the committee the National Weather Service Winter Storm Class will be November 8th at 7:00 p.m. located at Shepherdstown Fire Department. There have been 30 people to sign up so far.

Ms. Mehling reported the recommended EMI Course for September is IS-22, Are You Ready.

Ms. Mehling announced Fire Prevention Awareness Week will be October 3-9. Ms. Palmer asked if reading volunteers were needed. Ms. Mehling reported JCHSEM will not be reading to schools this year due to lack of materials.

Ms. Mehling noted Pam Holstein-Wallace is unavailable to update on the next round of Homeland Security Grants.

As Hurricane Earl Approaches East Coast, Seventh annual National Preparedness Month encourages Americans to take steps to prepare

WASHINGTON – Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Administrator Craig Fugate today kicked off the seventh annual National Preparedness Month, joining local Washington, D.C. officials and students from Ferebree-Hope Elementary School at the Serve DC Commander Ready event to talk about the importance of family and community emergency preparedness, especially as Hurricane Earl approaches the East Coast of the U.S. and other storms continue to form in the Atlantic Ocean.

"Hurricane Earl is another important reminder to all of us that every member of the community needs to be prepared for hurricanes and other disasters. Engaging with children on the topic of emergency preparedness is an effective way to bring home the preparedness message," said Fugate. "Local events like this one are happening all over the country throughout September to underscore the importance of getting people of all ages involved in preparing for emergencies."

National Preparedness Month is led by FEMA's Ready Campaign in partnership with Citizen Corps and The Advertising Council, and is a nationwide effort encouraging individuals, families, businesses and communities to work together and take action to prepare for emergencies. National Preparedness Month is supported by a coalition of public, private and non-profit organizations that help spread the preparedness message. This year's record number of coalition members are sharing preparedness information with their members, customers, employee, and communities. Members also spearhead activities that encourage specific steps for individual, neighborhood, and community preparedness.

In addition to the kickoff event, the Ready Campaign and Citizen Corps will sponsor activities across the country throughout September. Ready is introducing several new PSA campaigns and Citizen Corps is presenting its National Achievement Awards during September.
