Maggio, JCHSEM, Mike Davis, CERT; Patricia Davis, CERT; Katherine Dunbar, Good Shepherd Care Givers and Debbi Palmer, Eastern Panhandle ARC.

Ms. Mehling opened the meeting. Ms. Palmer approved the minutes from the previous meeting.

Old Business

Ms. Mehling reported the Disaster Ready Kids 2010 program had a total of 282 children. We are now shifting to October for Fire Prevention Month.

Ms. Mehling reviewed activities that went on during National Preparedness Month. Activities included Family Disaster Preparedness Night, Lunch N Learn sessions and discounts on disaster preparedness items at Wal-Mart.
