

MPOs are:

- Urban areas with population > 50,000 (Federal Highway Act 1962)
- Funded:
 - 80% Federal
 - o 10% State
 - 10% Local
- Administers of the <u>metropolitan transportation</u> <u>planning</u> process.

(Defined 23 U.S.C. 134)

- Interstate Council (Policy Board)
 - Elected Officials
 - State DOT Staff
 - Transit Providers
- Technical Advisory Committee
 - State Highway Engineers/Planners
 - County and City Engineers and Planners
 - Transit Operators
- Staff
 - Director
 - Transportation Planner
 - PT Administrative Support




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
MPOs are responsible for:


- Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP)
 - Evaluate predicted growth on transportation system 20 years out
- Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)
 - Four year program with all transportation projects receiving federal funding
- Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)
 - Outlines budget and work to be performed within fiscal year
- Title VI Plan
 - Ensures no one excluded from participation in MPO programs or activities
- Public Participation Plan (PPP)
 - How the public is involved in the metropolitan transportation planning process

















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




- US Bicycle Route 11 Designation Study












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The Statewide Transportation

regionally significant projects.


This capital improvement plan is fiscally constrained and covers a six year period.

Once the STIP is federally approved, certain changes must be made through an <u>amendment</u> and must undergo a public comment period:

- Federalizing any regionally significant/non-groupable, state funded project will require an Amendment to both TIP and STIP.
- Adding or deleting any project that adds a new traffic signal or pedestrian signal in an MPO area.
- Adding or deleting any phase of a project that affects air quality conformity regardless of funding source.
- Adding or deleting any phase of a project that changes traffic capacity of a road or bridge (i.e., the
- addition or deletion of through travel lanes).
- Major change in the scope of work or termini of a project (i.e., number of lanes, typical section,
- project termini).
- Adding or deleting any phase of a roadway expansion project.
- Adding any project or phase to the program that will be processed using AC.
- Adding a planned AC conversion to the program.
- Adding or deleting any phase of a regionally significant, non-federal project.
- Any cost change in a project phase, which is greater than \$2,000,000 or 10%, whichever is greater, of the
 previously approved estimate.
- Moving any individually listed project or phase from the constrained years to the informational years of the STIP or beyond.


Other types of changes may be made by an <u>administrative modification</u> (no public comment period).




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




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US340 Operational Improvements

- Public Meeting Aug. 2012 in Bolivar.
- Project approved as part of 2018 Roads to Prosperity (GO Bond Program; Wave "E"; \$11 million).
- Preliminary Investigation and Engineering Study completed Aug. 2020.
- Alternative 3B at US340/VA671 intersection selected...Continuous Green "T" with Two Lanes Northbound.
- Oct. 2020 Engineering
 Division recommends
 project be placed in reserve.
