- 1. There have been no JCDSCSC meetings held in the past year according to Will Liston and therefore no President Elect.

- 2. Steve Cox stressed the importance of following WV State Code (§7-14) Civil Service for Deputy Sheriffs.

 present) or may be given in person. There is also a physical agility test that is given. The

 development in JCDSCSC rules and the JCDSCSC adopts an online format.
- 4. It was suggested that Jefferson County follow the Rules and Regulations that Berkeley County (BCDSJCDSCSC) has already established for their JCDSCSC. We will make a decision on this matter after we review their Rules and Regulations and meeting with them. We will have our attorney review as well.
- 5. **Issue Raised:** Deputies' extra hours worked at race track or schools a portion of agreed upon fee between deputies and entity is kept by the Finance Director who determines the amount. Why? These hours are over and beyond their regular hours.

- 9. According to WV State Code (§7-14-7) deputies have probationary period of a year. Does JCSD follow this?
