Let's Play! Mobile Recreation



Jefferson County Parks and Recreation Commission is proud to be home to the "first mobile recreation van" in West Virginia. The idea was conceived in 2017 to address concerns for equitable access to recreational activities in our community. Jefferson County, like much of West Virginia has an economically diverse population and terrain. The van allows for play and STEM activities beyond the park borders. Let's Play! Mobile Recreation received a West Virginia Recreation and Park Association Award in 2018 and the Volunteer West Virginia Red Wagon Award in 2023.



KEEPING PLAY EQUITABLE & ACCESSIBLE

Funding sources from grants and donations has been instrumental to the success of the Mobile Recreation program in Jefferson County. Any donation amount will have a direct and immediate impact on our community. Donations will be used to engage kids in play, maintain supplies, and add new activities. Donations will be recognized through a social media post. Donations of \$10,000 or more will be recognized through logo display on mobile recreation vehicles.

Jefferson County Parks and Recreation organizes approximately ten to twelve community events each year focusing on children, family, and friends. Family event sponsors are invited to participate in events and support special touches that make memorable moments.

In-Kind Support



Your special equipment, animals, goods or skills can make a difference! Jefferson County Parks and Recreation enjoys a broad and diverse array of ideas and activities but there

are some things that just cannot be achieved without the support of our community. Giving families the opportunity to see, feel, and learn is an important element in community events. This is a great opportunity to leverage your interests and business to help create memorable experiences for parks and recreation participants.

Examples include:

- Cranes and ladder/bucket trucks for the Halloween Candy Drop.
- Goodies or snacks from a food business for participants.
- Equipment brought on-location for participants to touch or sit in/on.
- Donation of equipment delivery fees for necessary event supplies.
- Use of event spaces such as fields, gyms, banquet spaces, presentation

or banquet spaces.

Movie Nights in the Park are typically offered April - October or when weather permits.

SIGN SPONSORS

Business information and logos may be displayed in various locations, including in the Jefferson County Community Center gym, The AMP at Sam Michaels Park, and the Sam Michaels Dog Park. Signs are 18"x24" and hang for one year from the date they are posted.

The Jefferson County Community Center common area features a media wall including a large sponsorship tree display. Leaves are 2"x2" and can be personalized for a on-time fee of \$100. The leaf will remain on display for the life of the media wall giving a legacy to be enjoyed year after year.
