

Public Research Map – How to Guide

1. The Public Research Portal Page is located under the “Find It Fast” tab on the homepage



2. Click on the “Maps” Icon



3. Click on the “JC WV Public Research Map – GIS...” Icon

JC WV Public Research Map - GIS (Contains Addressing, Zoning, Zip, Floodplains, Parcels, etc)




JC WV Parcel Map - Assessor's Office (Contains Most Current Parcel Data)

4. Viewers can turn on / turn off various data layers using the options in the menu on the left side of the map. For example: checking the “Parcel” box will turn on the tax parcel data layer (boundaries are not survey accurate). To view Planning and Zoning data, check the “JC Planning and Zoning” box and then click the + sign to expand the menu options.
