





## Jefferson County Parks and Recreation Parks & Facilities

### Sam Michaels Park



The entrance to this 130-acre park is located on Job Corps Road, near Harpers Ferry. The private setting of this park offers the perfect place to host weddings, receptions, and reunions and family events. The well shaded Mason Picnic Pavilion offers an adjacent kitchen and restroom facility. The Veterans Memorial Pavilion offers picnic tables, bathrooms and close proximity to the large playground area and Jefferson County Community Center. You will also find The Columns at Sam Michaels, baseball fields, athletic fields, playgrounds, walking and running trails, dog park, disc golf, event space



The AMP at Sam Michaels Park; Jefferson County's newest concert and Festival Venue opened in Spring of 2019. The AMP is home to the Levitt AMP Shenandoah Junction Music Series, as well as a number of other community events including concerts, plays, movies in the park. and more.

### **Peter Burr Farm**

The oldest wood frame structure in West Virginia, Peter Burr Farm is owned and maintained by the Jefferson County Historic Landmarks Commission. They offer events and workshops to the public periodically though out the year. More information can be found at: http://www.jeffersoncountyhlc.org

### James Hite Park



Our newest 119-acre park that includes a 2-mile walking trail, soccer and and rentable picnic pavilions, and a playground. Future plans include, dog park and softball and football fields.

### **Bolivar Nature Park**



Located on primrose alley, near Harpers Ferry, this 7-acre park is filled with plenty of botanical delights. A walking trail allows you to stroll through the park.

### Mount Mission Park



This picturesque three and one-half acre park is located on Mission Road, near Shannondale. The picnic pavilion, complete with restroom and kitchen facilities, has played host to family reunions, weddings, and birthday parties. An old church on site, a newly renovated playground, basketball hoop, horseshoe pits, sand volleyball and a baseball diamond make this park a convenient site for neighborhood get-togethers.

### **Leetown Park**



Located one mile East of Leetown, off of old Leetown Pike, this 10-acre park has been a gathering spot since the 1970's. On the park grounds aremulti-purpose fields, tennis courts, a playground, and picnic pavilion. This park offers a great place to host your company's softball league or to simply relax and just play a pick-up game of baseball. Ball fields available for reservations.

### South Jefferson



Located on Route 1, between Summit Point and Middleway, this 71-acre park accommodates six baseball fields, tennis courts, concession stand, a playground, and basketball court.

### **Moulton Park**



On the shore of the Shenandoah River, just North of the Bloomery Bridge, this half-mile of river frontage features camping and other recreational opportunities. A public boat ramp gives access for fishing the Shenandoah River. In 2024, Moulton Park was expanded with the aquisition of an additional 83-acres. Future plans for the park include camping, trails, parking, fishing, disc golf, and more.
