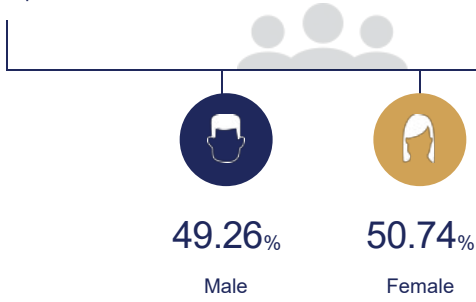

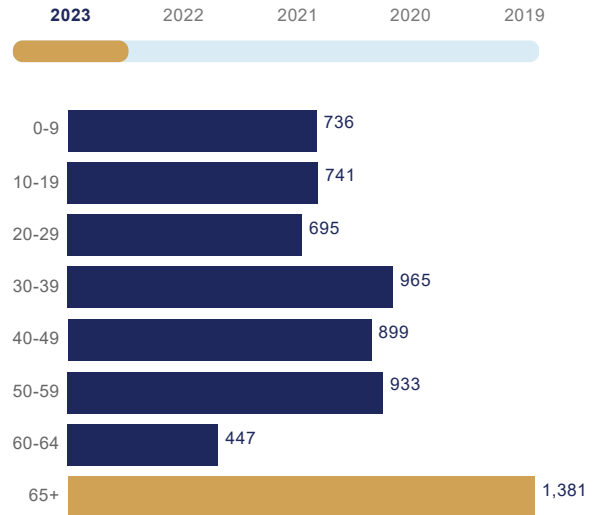
The total population of Charles Town is 6,797. The median age is 41.74

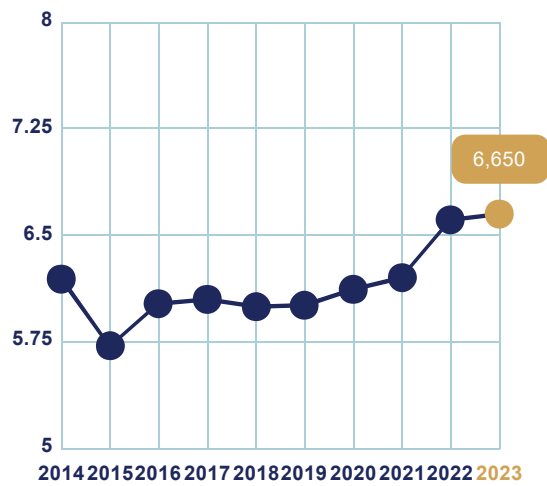
Age Distribution



Median Age

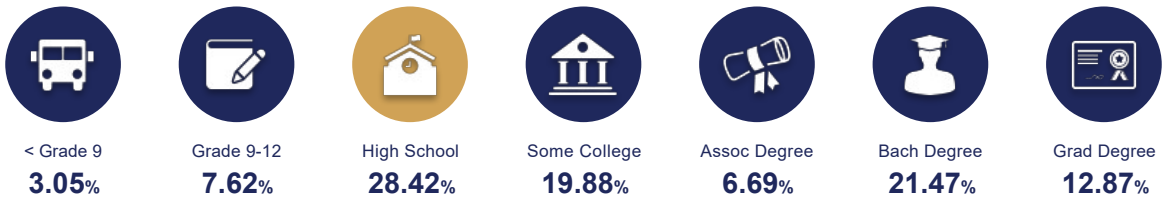

Labor Force

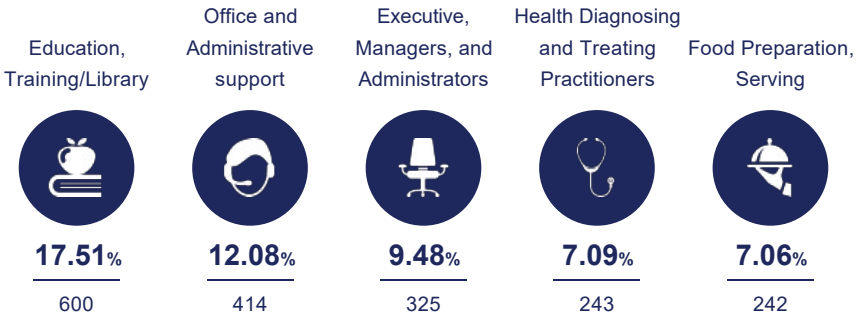

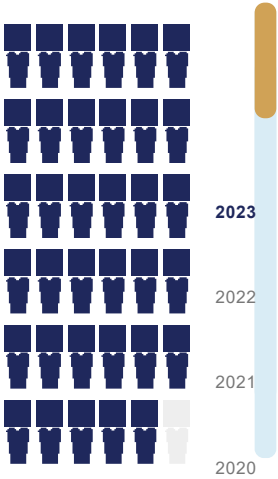

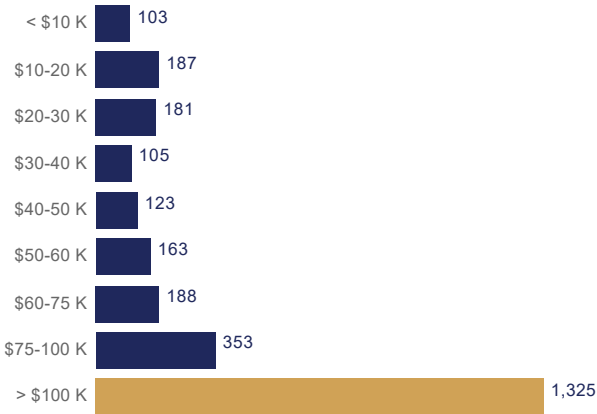

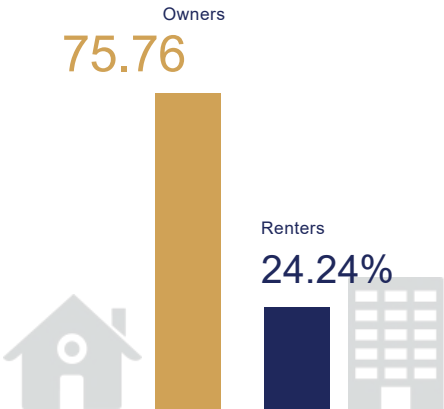
