A Public Hearing was held for the purpose of receiving comments on the Jefferson County Jail demolition historic review process.

Commission President Al Hooper read the notice of hearing as previously published.

Commissioner Hooper introduced Mr. Geoff Henry of URF Corporation of Gaithersburg, Maryland as well as Ms. Susan Pierce of the West Virginia Division of Culture and History. Ms. Pierce gave an analysis of the Historical Review process.
