

SPECIAL SESSION:

At a Special Session of the County Commission of said County and State continued and held at the Courthouse thereof on Friday, May 12, 2006, beginning at 9:30 o'clock a.m.

The County Commission of Jefferson County, sitting as a Board of Canvassers, met this 12th day of May, 2006 at 10:00 a.m. for the purpose of canvassing ballots cast in the May 9th, 2006 Primary Election.

The Board proceeded with the Canvass by reviewing each precinct one at a time, checking to make sure the counts were accurate and to review the provisional ballots from the polls and the ballots that were marked provisional at the Courthouse on election night due to missing poll clerk signatures. The Commission reviewed each provisional ballot to determine if the ballot could or could not be accepted to be counted.

Early Voting:

After review of the Early Vote totals, motion by Tabb, second by Surkamp to accept the totals of 864 ballots cast, 868 poll stubs, 9 spoiled ballots and 0 provisional ballots. Motion carried.

The Commission revisited the Early Vote totals later in the day after discovering 4 provisional ballots that had been pulled election night at the Courthouse due to the absence of 1 or more poll clerk signatures. Motion by Manuel, second by Surkamp to accept the 4 provisional ballots with missing poll clerk signatures. Motion carried. The count for Early Voting was reconciled with the addition of the 4 provisional ballots.
