At a Special Session of the County Commission of said County and State held at the Courthouse thereof on Tuesday, November 9, 2010, beginning at 9:00 a.m.

The County Commission of Jefferson County, sitting as a Board of Canvassers, met this 9th day of November, 2010 at 9:00 a.m. for the purpose of receiving the results of the recount of the ballots of Precinct 26, which ballots were cast in the November 2, 2010 General Election. No video or audio will be utilized until the Counters complete the recount and provide the Commissioners with their results.

Jennifer Maghan, County Clerk, and Nikki Painter, from the County Clerk's office, were present during the recount.

At 11:30 a.m. the video and audio were activated. The Counters reported that upon recount the ballots fell within the one percent (1%) of the allowable margin of error. The Canvassers thanked the Counters for their hard work and dismissed them from any further duty herein.

Sitting as a Board of Canvassers, Commissioners Noland, Widmyer and Morgan verified absentee and provisional ballots for Precinct 26.

The Board of Canvassers recessed at 11:50 a.m. and reconvened at 1:00 p.m.

Ms. Maghan reported that the results cannot be certified until the last county has been counted.

Motion by Ms. Morgan to set the bond amount at Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00). Motion seconded by Ms. Noland and unanimously approved.

Motion by Ms. Morgan to declare the election canvass completed. Motion seconded by Ms. Noland and unanimously approved.
