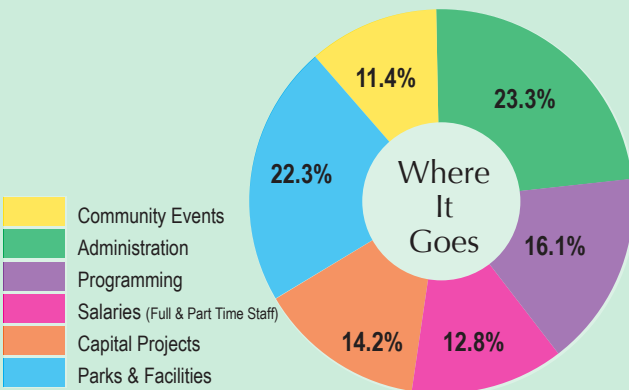
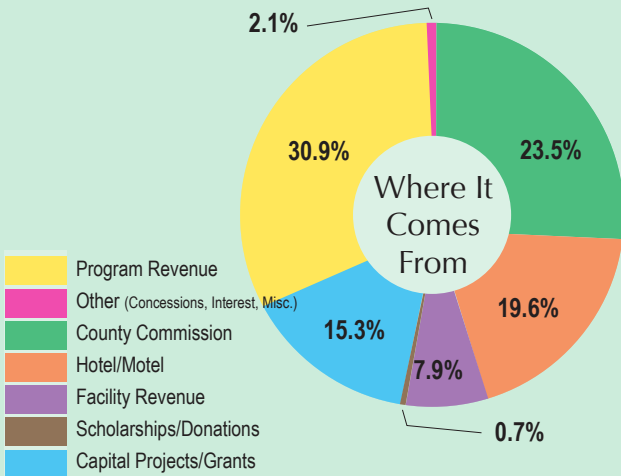
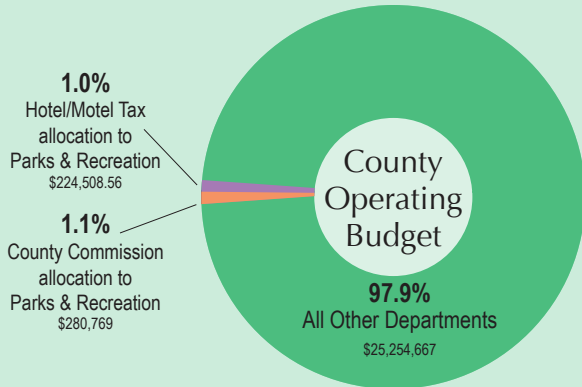


Parks & Recreation Funding

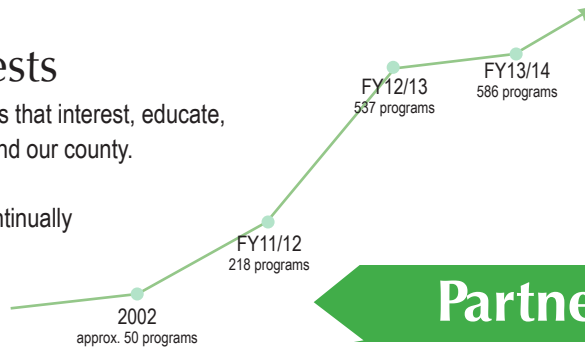
